Each year the Chi Psi Educational Foundation provides the funding for this program. The merit award criteria are based on an applicant's overall accomplishments and excellence in all areas of interest in addition to academic performance.

Who is Chi Psi? The Chi Psi National Fraternity (www.chipsi.org) was founded in 1841 and is the seventh oldest Greek letter society in the nation. The Oregon chapter of Chi Psi (www.etadelta.org) was founded in 1921 and has occupied their house referred to as the "Lodge" at 1018 Hilyard St since it opened in 1936. The Alpha Eta Delta of Chi Psi Educational Foundation was established in 1970 and is a tax deductible 501 c-3 charitable organization that provides scholarships and other funding to support the academic endeavors of members of Chi Psi and other students at the University of Oregon.
